PXL/ED/DCGI/2014-15/001/Rep-36/82 dated 27/05/2015 from Dr. P V Appaji, Director General, Pharmexcil on the subject stating that ADCs posted at the various ports take the export shipment files once a day. The files collected in the morning are reverted in the evening. Hence, the objections, if any, are informed in the evening thereby wasting one full day. He also suggested that, inspections should be carried out on 02 (two) hourly basis

In this connection, it is directed that shipping bills of export consignments received at the port offices should be processed at the earliest i.e. may be within 02 (Two) to 04 (Four) hours of submission of bills and details about status of bill should be informed to the exporters or his agent immediately after processing.
